



Case Studies

Swiss artist Felice Varini is installing a 542m-long artwork along the façades of heritage buildings in London's historic King's Cross. The site-specific installation, titled 'Across the Buildings', is a lighting projection of gargantuan geometric shapes, which span the entire length of Granary Square. From street level the configuration of the shapes appears arbitrary, however from a single unique viewpoint the pieces come together to form an interconnecting pattern. This is the third artwork to be revealed as part of RELAY, the dedicated art programme at King's Cross curated by Michael Pinsky and Stéphanie Delcroix. From 16 May until 18 October.
