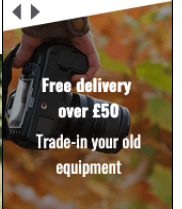

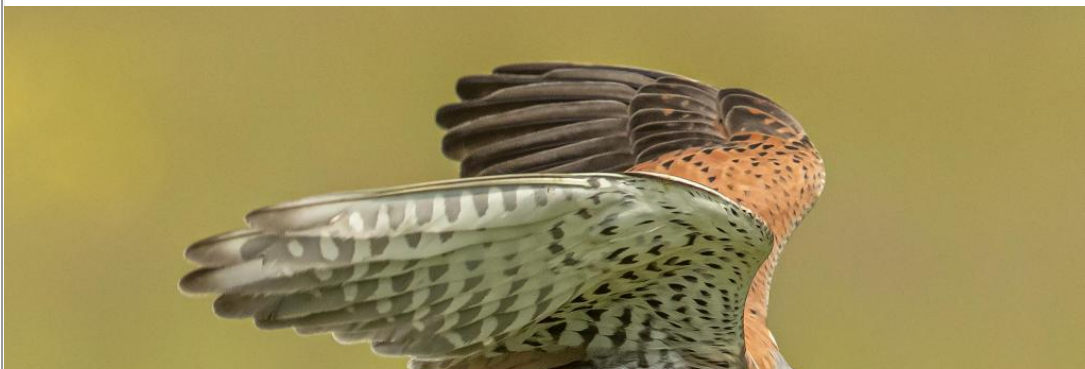
Australia A faced an uphill battle as the second day of their match against England Women started in Derby. They were all out for 221, and England were at one point 502-4

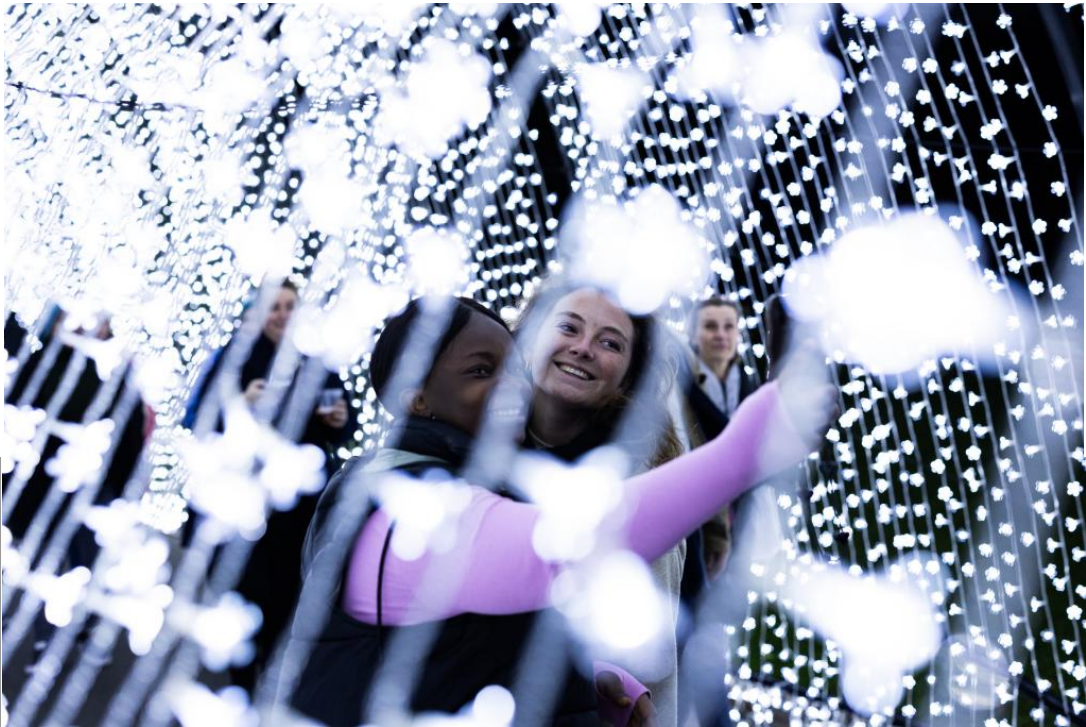

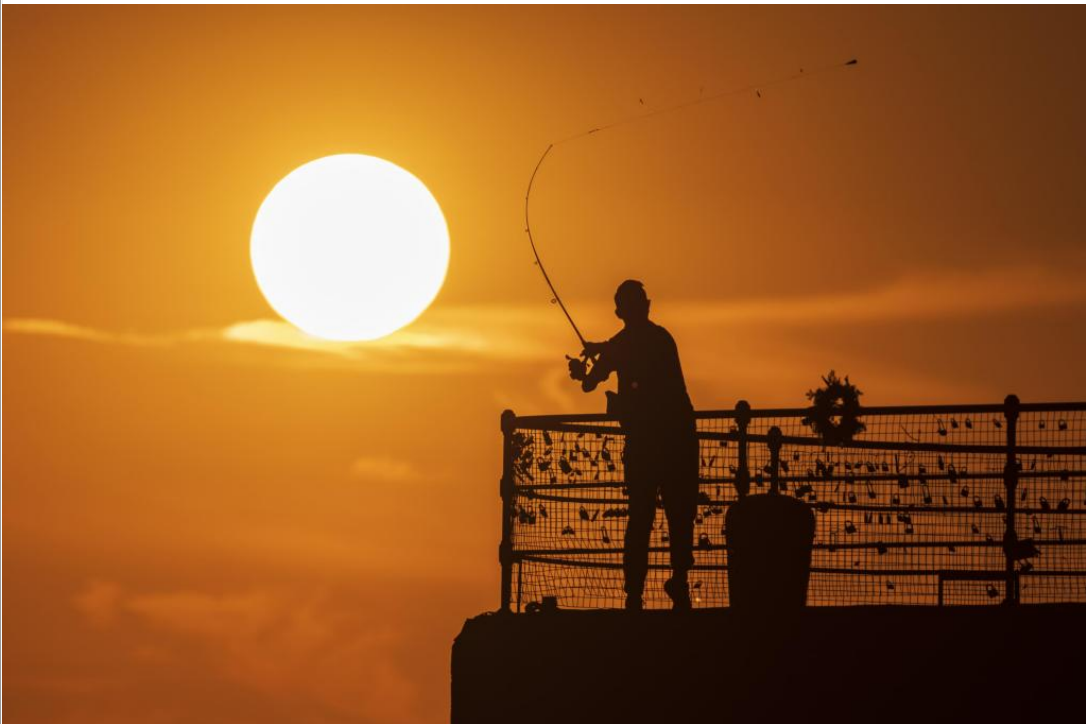
